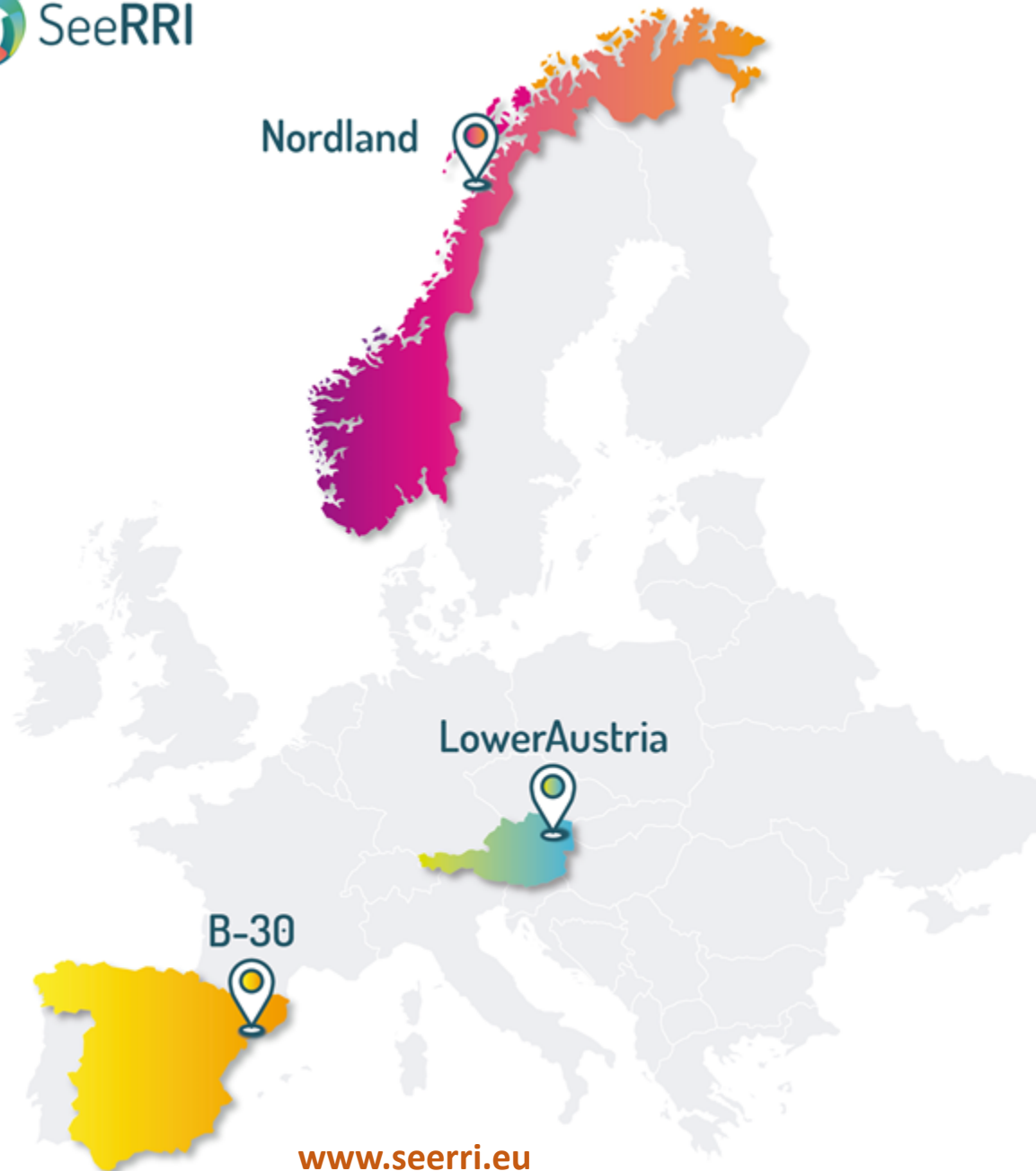

Why foresight with stakeholder engagement?

Today, there is increasing demand on prospective and strategic methods and tools in politics and management, because:



1. Acceleration of change in science and society requires scenarios beyond short-term planning.



2. There is increasing interdependence and international networking ("complexity") – here classic planning has its limits.

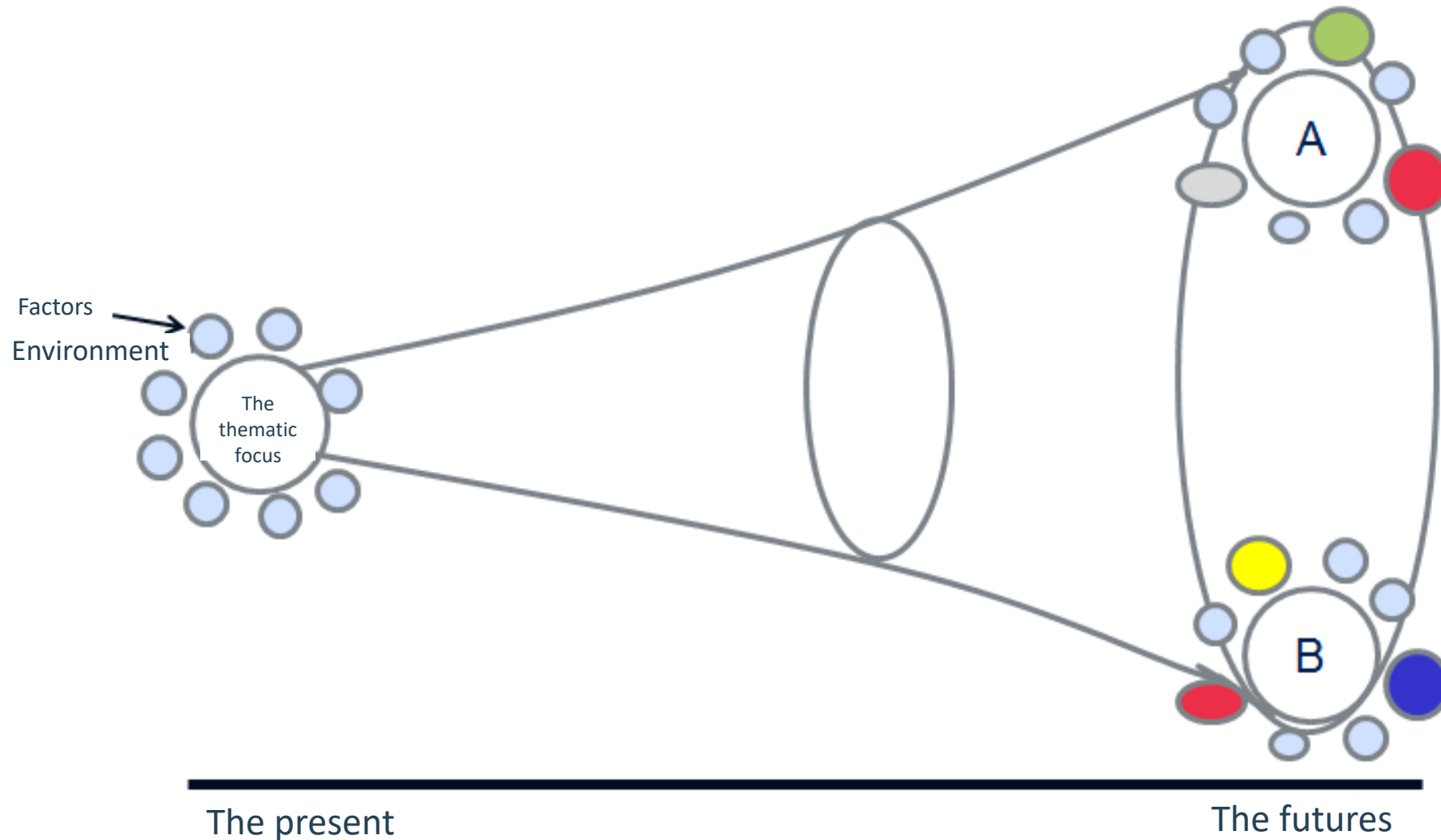


3. The scope of actions for individual actors are limited. Therefore, this needs coordinated actions.
